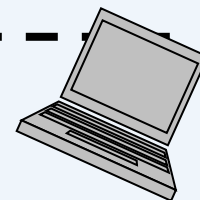

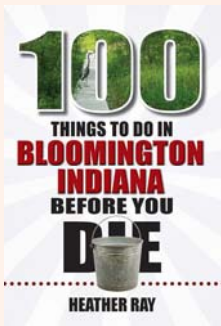

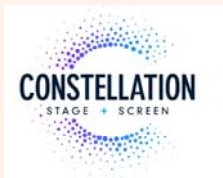
BNNC meetings will be at Hoosier Hank's East, 1285 S College Mall Rd.
